Ongoing needs

Cleaning Supplies:

- Paper towels

- Bottle of medical alcohol for sterilizing
- Box of bandaging squares for wound care 2x2 or 3x3

General Facility Needs:

- Money to purchase food and maintain cages.
- Facial tissue white only (no additives)
- 1 and 2 Gallon size Ziplock freezer bags
- Multi use computer paper
- Gift Cards to Walmart, Target, Lowe's

Feed Stuffs:

- Wild bird seed
